Wabasha is your premier four-season recreation destination. Known for its extraordinary natural beauty, Wabasha is nestled between the rugged soaring limestone bluffs of southeastern Minnesota and the majestic Mississippi River. More than just a picturesque historic river town, Wabasha draws tourists from all over the world. Many activities take advantage of its unique location.

Boaters enjoy the ever-changing river with its wide channel, quiet backwaters, and abundant sandbars perfect for picnics or overnight camping. If kayaks or canoes are more your style, the Mississippi and nearby Zumbro River offer scenic stretches filled with wildlife.

Wabasha is home to the National Eagle Center, a world-renowned museum and interpretive center dedicated to eagles and other wildlife indigenous to the Upper Mississippi River watershed. Nearly half of all waterfowl use the Mississippi River flyway for migration or nesting. The National Eagle Center offers unmatched opportunities for viewing them as well as exhibits, field-trips, and programming.

If golf is more your forte, join us at the Coffee Mill Golf Course, an eighteen-hole course perched high atop Coffee Mill Bluff which has stunning vistas of the Mississippi and Chippewa River valleys. Or head to Kellogg and play a round of mini-golf at LARK Toys, recently named one of the ten best toy stores in the entire world by USA Today!

If biking is your passion, Wabasha is located on the Mississippi River Trail and the city itself is bike friendly. Bring your fishing gear and join us for a lazy afternoon trolling for walleye or get serious and enter one of the fishing tournaments that call Wabasha home.

When autumn arrives, the bluffs explode with color. Not to be outdone by Mother Nature, the entire town of Wabasha decks itself out with pumpkin topiaries and harvest-themed decorations. SeptOberfest runs from September 15-October 12th, and draws visitors from around the country for craft boutiques, German food, and fun activities for adults and children.

When the snow flies, the Coffee Mill Ski Area is the place to be with one of the longest vertical drops in the area. If you're less skilled, but equally playful, join in the fun with snow tubing. Wabasha is surrounded by groomed trails for snowmobilers and ice fishing opportunities are abundant. If you are truly adventurous, join us in February for the Grumpy Plunge and jump into the frigid Mississippi to support local charities.

Not a winter person? Pamper yourself! Get away to one of the wonderful lodging properties in the area and curl up by the fire.

Hiking Trails & Walking Tours

Enjoy the Driftless Area up close with hundreds of hiking trails throughout Wabasha County. From casual walking trails in downtown Wabasha to miles of groomed trails within our public land and state parks, we have endless hiking opportunities for all ages. Challenge yourself and hike to the top of the bluffs for stunning views of the river valley and soaring eagles below.

Here are a few trails to check out:

Kruger Campground & DUA offers wheelchair-accessible trails, fishing, hunting, hiking trails, canoe access, picnic area with shelters, nature trails and campsites.

Snake Creek includes two trail systems varying in length and difficulty available for all trail users except 4-wheel-drive vehicles

Whitewater State Park gives visitors access to rugged hiking trails that lead to scenic bluffland overlooks.



Biking

Explore the Mississippi River Trail and Great River Road in Minnesota & Wisconsin with over 225 miles of mapped biking routes! Each route offers a different level of difficulty, beautiful sights and an opportunity to take in our local flora and fauna.

- Nine uniquely mapped trails ranging from one to thirtynine miles
- Miles of public state land paths shared with hikers and outdoor enthusiasts
- Download the Bloom Bike app and rent a bike to explore downtown Wabasha and the local trails.

Wabasha is part of The Driftless Area, a land untouched by glaciers. This gives riders a unique opportunity to ride the bluffs and challenge themselves to the elevation of the uneven landscape.



Boating & Sightseeing

Cruise by land or water and discover why Wabasha is named the Official Bald Eagle Capital of America! The scenic overlooks of the Great River Road on both sides of the river offer unobstructed views all along the river valley. The river below is always teaming with activity from wildlife and people alike. Grab the family for a fun day relaxing on one of our island chains or take it up a notch for epic water adventures on Lake Pepin! Hungry after a day on the river? Dock your boat at a riverside restaurant.



Canoeing/Kayaking

Connect with the Mississippi on a kayak or canoeing adventure. Join Broken Paddle Guiding for daily guided tours, rentals, and kayak lessons in the scenic waters of the Mississippi River's tributaries, bluff lands, and old-growth floodplain forests. Or, grab the family and launch at one of our public canoe landings for a fun day on the water.



Golfing

Don't miss the chance to play a round on the beautiful 18-hole course at the Coffee Mill Golf Course perched high atop Coffee Mill Bluff with stunning vistas of the Mississippi and Chippewa River valleys. Or head to Kellogg and play a round of mini-golf at LARK Toys, complete with fun challenges and two working waterfalls!



Skiing / Snowshoeing

Coffee Mill Ski & Snowboarding is Wabahsa's premier winter resort with 28 acres of trails. This hidden gem offers runs for all levels of skiers and snowboarders. And, yes, we really do bring the challenge with the longest vertical drop south of Duluth. If you'd rather enjoy the snow at your own pace, our snowshoe and cross-country ski trails are perfect for you. Follow along one of our mapped paths or create your own with access to hundreds of acres of public land.



ATV / UTV / Snowmobiling

Southern Minnesota boasts hundreds of miles of off-road trails, and Wabasha County is in the heart of it all! Our state trails and recreation areas give riders access to a full network of fun and challenging adventures. When Winter settles in, many of our ATV/UTV trails transform into epic snowmobiling routes. The Wabasha Area Driftskippers also maintain 89 miles of well-groomed trails. All you need is a tank of gas and a sense of adventure to explore our breathtaking landscapes!



Hunting/Fishing

Wabasha is home to some of the best recreational hunting and fishing in the country! Every year, thousands of hunters and fishermen come to Wabasha looking to claim their prize game and catch. And, with miles of public access to land, water and streams, you can spend the day surrounded by the sounds of nature.

From waterfowl hunting on the renowned Mississippi Flyway, to Spring turkeys, to white-tail deer, our waters, bluffs and woodlands are teaming with sporting opportunites. Take advantage of thousands of acres of state forests and public access points.

Take to the water in a boat, from shore, or wading in a clear fresh spring fed stream and you'll find great fishing holes throughout the area, no matter what your target fish is. Hook up the boat or round up the ice fishing gear for year-round water adventures.

BEACH PARK

Located on the west end of Main Street.

This park is located on the banks of the Mississippi River and features a spacious beach area. The park offers various amenities including a picnic pavilion, gazebo, playground, beach area, and public restroom facilities with showers. There are also walking paths that provide scenic views of the nearby marina. The park allows reservations for private weddings held in the Gazebo or private events under the picnic pavilion. Additionally, there is a municipal campground adjacent to the park that offers 51 seasonal sites and 1 transient site for daily rental.

BRUEGGER PARK

Located on the west side of town on Gambia Avenue.

Approximately two acres in size, families will find a playground for children, picnic shelter, and picnic tables.

CANNON PARK

Located just off Hiawatha Drive East.

This park features a prominent WWI cannon from the early 1900s. The cannon was almost destroyed but, thanks to community members, was placed in the park and has become a landmark near the middle of town.

DENNIS PFEILSTICKER MEMORIAL PARK Located off Hiawatha Drive East next to city hall.

This park is in memory of Dennis Pfeilsticker, a dedicated ambulance emergency medical technician who served the residents and the youth of Wabasha for many years. In his memory, his family sponsored the playground equipment here. Located next to the park is the city pool, which includes a splash pad, climbing wall, diving board, and water slide. The pool is open from early June through mid-August and is the perfect place to cool off on hot summer days!

EDWARD MALONE MEMORIAL PARK Located off Grant Boulevard.

This 4-acre park features two shelters, a children's playground area, a handicap-accessible fishing dock for anglers, and public restrooms. Visitors can also enjoy BBQ pits, horseshoes, a portable volleyball net, and a walking trail.

HERITAGE PARK

Located under the Interstate bridge on Main Street.

This park has a pleasant picnic area with tables and benches, as well as a stage that hosts entertainment year-round. The River Junctions Arts Council sponsors free outdoor concerts on Fridays during the summer months.

HEROES PARK

Located on Rice & Belvidere Street, Kellogg.

In the middle of Kellogg's downtown you will find a large, square block public park with lots of open space, a playground and basketball courts, and a large covered picnic area. Kellogg is a great community to take the kids to play - and we're small enough that we don't have a stoplight anywhere in town!

JAYCEE PARK

Located on Bailey and 12th Street.

This park spans over 2 acres and offers plenty of room for frisbee golf and softball activities.

SCHMIDT PARK

Located on East Second Street.

It was originally donated to the city in the early 1900s, but it was later abandoned. In recent years, the park was donated back to the city by Paul Busch, a resident of Wabasha. Thanks to generous donations from the community, the park has been restored to its original appearance. It now features a fountain, walkway, entrance posts, antique lighting, and flower gardens. Memorial Day services are held at the park.

THRIVE! PARK

Located in the Village of Nelson.

Thrive! Park is a public park, unique in that it consists of over 25 acres of Mississippi River bluff top and bluff side. The primary bluff is Three Sisters (northernmost Sister is private land) and Lost Brother. The three southernmost bluff tops (two of the Sisters and Lost Brother) are in the Park and accessible via hiking roads and trails.

VETERANS MEMORIAL PARK

Located at the intersection of Hiawatha Drive East and Hwy 60.

This park features a Veterans Monument, the American Flag, and flags representing all military branches.

Located on Bailey Avenue, between 11th and 12th Street.
